Whereas at a Meeting of the Male persons of full age, belonging to the Episcopal Church at the Yonkers in the County of Westchester and State of New York in pursuance of the Act of the Legislature of the said State passed April the 6th 1784 Entitled an Act to enable all the Religious Denominations in this State to Appoint Trustees who shall be a body Corporate for the purpose of taking care of the Temporalities of their respective Congregations and for other purposes therein mentioned for the purpose of Electing Nominating and Appointing Trustees to take charge of the Estate and property belonging to the said Church and to Transact all affairs relating to the Temporalities thereof, the persons so Met did previously proceed to Nominate and Elect Frederick Van Cortlandt and Thomas Vollentine two of the Members of the said Church to hold the said Election and be the returning officers thereof. We therefore the said Frederick Van Cortlandt and Thomas Vollentine so nominated and Elected to preside at and be the Returning officers as aforesaid, do Certify that at the said Election so held as aforesaid Jonah Honeywill Jun. Augustus Van Cortlandt and John Warner were Elected to Serve as Trustees for the Episcopal Church at the Yonkers in the County of Westchester and State of New York and we do Accordingly return the said persons as duly elected Witness our hands and seals this fifteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one Thousand and seven Hundred and Eighty seven
